Practising on the Course

Recently there have been a growing number of incidents of people breaking club policies on the course. The latest two incidences occurred on a weekend in May with one person hitting multiple balls around the third green and another with a bucket of balls, hitting off the 2nd tee resulting in multiple divot marks on the course. Incidents normally occur on parts of the course away from the clubhouse and during off peak hours so the perpetrators are aware that they are breaking the rules. The policy is that no practice is permitted on the course outside of the permitted practice area. It is perfectly acceptable for members to play a round of golf on their own and to play each hole with up to two balls. However, you must finish out the hole as if playing normally without repeating shots from the same spot on the course resulting in multiple divot marks on the course.
