

CARNALEA GOLF CLUB STANDARD OF DRESS

Applicable to members and guests

Carnalea Golf Club subscribes to the codes for Standard of dress recommended by the [Golfing Union of Ireland](#) and the [Irish Ladies Golfing Union](#).

Whilst we wish our Members and Visitors to feel at ease, smart dress is required at all times and we would ask you to observe our dress standards. Any clothes worn including denim must not be soiled as in work jeans, not torn or frayed or with appendages such as chains attached.

The Club reserves the right to refuse access to the Clubhouse or Course to anyone dressed inappropriately.

DRESS CODE SUMMARY

Club House

The following items of dress **are not** acceptable at any time:

- Caps
- Shirts specific to other sports – soccer, rugby, polo etc.
- Singlets, sleeveless or collarless shirts
- Clothing displaying large non-golf related slogans or logos
- Tracksuits
- Any footwear worn on the course

All shorts and trousers must be tailored. Sports shorts are not allowed to be worn. Cut off trousers must also be tailored. Gentlemen must always wear socks with shorts. Ladies may choose not to wear socks in the club house

Function Nights

Smart casual dress apart from denims of any kind may be worn at all function nights apart from Special Function Nights when Council deem it appropriate to wear a jacket and tie.

Restaurant

Members & Visitors are required to wear smart dress in the Ailsa Craig Suite on a Saturday evening. Please note that denims are deemed inappropriate.

On the Course

The following items of dress **are not** acceptable at any time:

- Shirts specific to other sports – soccer, rugby, polo etc.
- Singlets, collarless shirts or sleeveless shirts (permissible if worn with collars by ladies)
- Clothing displaying large non-golf related slogans or logos
- Tracksuits
- Sports shorts
- V-neck sweaters with no shirt
- Sun tops or beachwear
- Torn frayed or soiled clothes of any description or with appendages such as chains
- Trousers are not to be worn inside socks

Staff and Council Members are authorised to approach members and visitors if the dress regulations are not being adhered to. Please do not run the risk of embarrassment of being refused service.
