

Carnalea Golf Club - COVID-19 – 17th March 2020

Given the latest Government direction to avoid unnecessary social contact in Bars / Clubs we have no option given the health & safety of staff and members but to close the Clubhouse with immediate effect. This decision was taken by Council this morning.

The entire Clubhouse will be closed with no access including the Bar, Catering & Snooker Rooms.

Voting forms if hand delivered should be in a sealed envelope and can be posted through the letterbox in the door of the old Starter's Hut.

The course will remain open for casual golf only – please book through BRS.

We recommend that you maintain sensible personal precautions including avoiding contact with others, maintaining safe distances, catching all coughs and sneezes in a tissue and discarding it. Avoid touching your face at any time.

Bunkers will be out of play given rakes would require handling. We recommend you play with the pin in to avoid handling also.

There will be no competitions until further notice – the Saturday timesheet will be live from 28th March but will be for casual play only – if you do not intend to play please remove your name.

Thomas has indicated that at this stage he intends to remain open – this may change over time. We would recommend that you maintain safe distances within the shop and avoid numbers of people at any given time.

The locker & trolley rooms will be open – however shower areas will be closed. The Locker rooms will be deep cleaned each morning however we would recommend you take precautions such as gloves or tissues when opening doors etc

Some golfers may prefer to remove their clubs / trolley to their car during this period.

As ever Council will review this position as Govt & Public Health advice changes.
