Carnalea Golf Club - Important Update 16th March 2020

COVID-19 (coronavirus) – Important Update Carnalea Golf Club

It has been decided today (Monday 16th March) that in order to restrict numbers present in the clubhouse, we will not proceed with any event which would potentially bring large numbers into the clubhouse at any one time, which may compromise personal spacing. This has the following impacts:

- The AGM due to be held on Monday 23rd March will now be conducted entirely remotely with voting by email, post / hand delivery – an email will follow with further details
- Captain's Inaugural – Saturday 28th March – this will be postponed until the first available Saturday night post the current situation

The following events will now unfortunately be cancelled:

- Steak Night – Saturday 21st March
- Mothering Sunday – Sunday 22nd March
- Remaining Bowls and Bingo nights
- All Friday night entertainment in March.

Council will continue to review the response required within the Golf Club given the current Government, HSE & Public Health (NI) Advice We will continue to monitor changes in advice and update our position accordingly.

The health and safety of Carnalea Golf Club members, visitors and staff remains our priority.

Please stay at home if you feel unwell per the public advice.

Clubhouse

At present the Clubhouse / bar remains open. We would ask you to maintain as much space as possible between tables utilising the dining area also. The Caterer remains open albeit with a more restricted menu during this period.

We would ask that you use 'V1 app' card upload and contactless payments where possible in the bar – avoiding cash payments as much as possible. When you present your bar card please leave it on the counter where staff can read your member number for the till, rather than handling your card.

We recommend that again, members & visitors to the clubhouse maintain the highest standards of good personal hygiene:

- Catch any sneezes or coughs in a tissue and discard used tissues immediately
- Avoid shaking hands / kissing when greeting others - perhaps adopt the 'chicken wing' elbow touch
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose & mouth with unwashed hands
- Thoroughly wash your hands regularly whilst in the clubhouse - 20 to 30 secs thoroughly washing with soap is recommended. Soap is available in all toilets. Thorough washing of hands is recommended by public health.

Keycodes have been disabled on the front door and at the snooker room to minimise common / regular touchpoints.

Golf

The Course remains open for competitions and general play.

We recommend that players maintain good personal practice:

- Maintain distance between yourself and playing partners as much as possible avoiding any unnecessary contact
- Catch any sneezes or coughs in a tissue and discard used tissues immediately
- Lift the pin by a gloved hand
- Avoid shaking hands after a match - perhaps adopt the 'chicken wing' elbow touch
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose & mouth with unwashed hands
- Thoroughly wash your hands regularly - especially after entering or leaving any premise - 20 to 30 secs thoroughly washing with soap is recommended. Soap is available in all toilets and in the locker room. Thorough washing of hands is recommended by public health.
